In April 2008, I issued an evaluation of the Delaware Township School District pursuant to the requirements of the New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC), N.J.A.C. 6A:30 et seq. At that time, I placed the district on a continuum in each of the areas evaluated in the district performance review (DPR): instruction and program, fiscal management, operations, personnel and governance.

Following that initial evaluation, the district developed an improvement plan, which was approved in April 2009. Staff from the Hunterdon County Office of Education conducted a review of the district's progress toward addressing the missed indicators in the DPR area of instruction and program. Based on that review, I am updating the placement of the district on the QSAC continuum in the area of instruction and program. Listed below are both the initial placement and the review placement scores for your district:
